- This week the reception children had a visit from local fire fighters, see more on the next page! The children also had a visit from Santa and an Elf. They enjoyed every moment. In Maths we have focused on the number 5. Recognising it, saying it, writing it and then trying to count out 5 object. We have written letters to Santa, using our new phonics sound 'f'. We have also been rehearsing for our show next week.
- A busy week for year 1 this week with a visit from Santa, his elves and our singing performance. All of the Year 1 teachers were so proud of how well the children have done learning the songs and practising getting on and off the stage. We hope you enjoyed watching it as much as we did! Our focus for this week was on the Christmas Nativity story for our writing and the children retold the story of when Jesus was born. The children also found out about Christmas trees and why we have them in our homes. They learnt that a Christmas tree is called a Pine tree and that it is evergreen. They found out the names of other evergreen trees we might see around Christmas (Ivy and Holly) and some deciduous trees too (Oak and Sycamore).
- What a busy week! As well as fitting in extra rehearsals for our Christmas performance, it has been business as usual in the Year 2 classrooms. We have begun to explore the concept of multiplication as repeated addition in Maths, and we have represented this using grouping and arrays. We really enjoyed reading the children's stories about a mischievous Christmas Elf! We carried out another investigation in Science, exploring how forces (such as stretching, twisting and bending) can affect different materials. We have continued our study of the work of ceramicist Clarice Cliff in Art and the children have just loved working with clay.

We are almost there, one more week to go! Every week at Crawley Ridge is busy, but this week we have been busier than usual. We started our Christmas events with the most delightful visit from Santa - yes, actual Santa. He came with presents for each classroom (funded by the PTA) and all children sat and listened to him talking about Christmas and what it really means. Year one children kicked-off our Christmas performances yesterday. Through lots of tear filled eyes, we watched children perform, have fun and sing their hearts out - well done children, we feel extra Christmassy now! Next week it will be Reception and Year 2's turn, I have no doubt that they will also give an amazing performance. We also had a visit from Surrey fire fighters and their fire engine. I have never seen so many children giggle, smile and get stuck in with all of the activities they had to offer. We have some budding fire fighters on our hands. Next week the fun will continue with Christmas lunches, arts and crafts afternoons and Christmas jumper day. We break up next Friday 17th December at the earlier time of 2pm. 

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
