It finally feels like summer is here! Today staff made sure children drank plenty of water, did not exert themselves too much in the sun and sought shade when needed. We reduced some aspects of our PE lessons to ensure the children were comfortable. We erected additional gazebos to increase shaded areas in the playground. Did you know that children can't regulate their own body temperature? This means they can't always decipher if they are too hot or cold. For this reason, staff ensured jumpers and cardigans were not worn today. Thank you for applying sun cream in the morning; for many reasons we can't apply cream to children's hands for them to apply themselves.

Can I also ask parents to make sure they call and inform the office team of their child's absence before 9am. This morning alone, our staff had to call multiple parents who had not made contact with us. This takes up valuable time that staff could otherwise be using to enhance and build upon our curriculum areas.

In assemblies this week I have been asking children to recall lessons and learning points from October. I couldn't believe how much the children had remembered. Reception This week our story has been *Commotion in the Ocean* by Giles Andreae. We have been learning all about how to help our oceans stay clean and safe and about water safety. We have explored, created and written about different sea creatures. In maths we have been focusing on doubling numbers and amounts up to 10. The children learnt that 'double' is 'twice as many'. Can your child tell you any doubling facts? In phonics we have continued to revisit all of our phase 2 and 3 sounds, ensuring we are using correct letter formation and finger spaces. We are really looking forward to our pirate topic next week and our special pirate dress up day on Wednesday.

Year 1 This week the children have been finding out about coasts in Geography by thinking of different features of a British coastline and using maps to identify these features. The children enjoyed listening to stories of Katie Morag to help them with this. They had to think about how Katie's Ted felt when she kicked him into the sea during a storm and wrote a letter as Ted to their own teddies telling them about his misadventure. In Maths they have begun working with numbers to 100 and have been finding the place value of each digit. The children were thrilled to meet the local author Alison Simpson and enjoyed listening to her reading her book 'Bodhi the Pirate Dog'. The children loved hearing about the real Bodhi and asked lots of questions about becoming an author. After completing the phonic screening check we have now begun introducing alternative graphemes for the /ai/ sound for example in the words acorn, grey, great and eight.

Year 2 As the weather has become hotter and hotter as the week has gone by, it has been business as usual in Year 2 and we are very proud of our children for keeping going despite the heat! We have continued to revise some of the Maths topics we have covered earlier in the year. As we move towards the end of term our thoughts are, of course, turning to transition. The Year 2 children wanted to share their knowledge and wisdom with their younger school mates and have written information leaflets about Year 2 for the children who will be moving up from Year 1.




