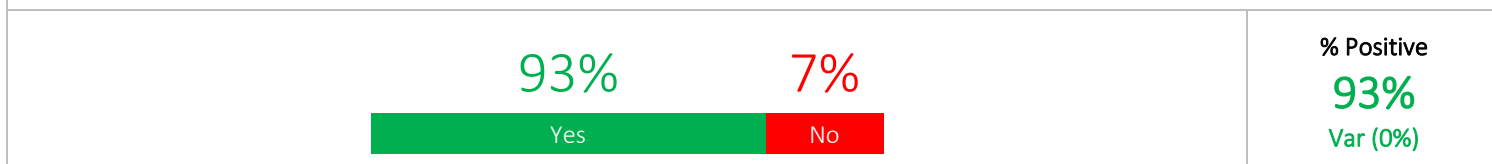

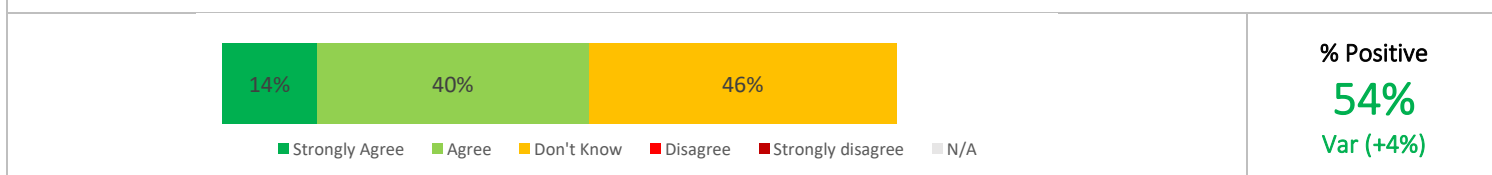

Overview of Additional Comments



- Many parents express high satisfaction with the school, highlighting the welcoming environment, dedicated staff, and the positive impact on their children's learning and wellbeing.
- Some parents feel there are gaps in communication regarding their child's progress, development, and how they can better support learning at home.

- Mixed feedback on the school reading scheme, with some parents finding books too challenging for their child’s learning stage and suggesting better alignment between school and home reading.
- Positive experiences shared by new families, with children settling in well, enjoying a broader curriculum, and feeling more engaged than at previous schools.
- Appreciation for the caring and supportive team, but concern over the lack of response between families and our SEND provision, acknowledging challenges with resourcing in this area.
- Calls for a designated quiet area for Reception children, both indoors and outdoors, to provide space for those needing a break from busy school activities.
- A willingness from some parents to support fundraising efforts, including offering skills in grant writing and volunteering.
- Some concerns about the cost of the after-school club and its accessibility for all families.

Overview of Parent Survey



The parent survey feedback shared in February 2025 highlights strong overall satisfaction with Crawley Ridge Infant School. Parents widely praise the school’s welcoming environment, dedicated staff, and the positive impact on their children’s learning and wellbeing. Many feel their children are happy and thriving, with particular appreciation for the support provided by teachers and the leadership team. The school is recognised as a nurturing space where children settle well, and most parents would confidently recommend it to others.

While feedback was largely positive, some areas for improvement were noted. A key theme was communication, with some parents wanting more regular updates on their child’s progress and clearer guidance on how to support learning at home. Concerns were also raised about the reading scheme, with some feeling that books sent home were too advanced. Additional feedback included concerns about children’s privacy on social media, the high cost of after-school provision, and delays in responses to parents with whom their child has special needs. Despite these suggestions for improvement, parents remain highly supportive of the school, with many expressing gratitude for the efforts of staff and the positive experiences their children have at Crawley Ridge Infant School.
