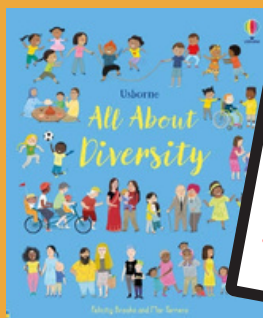

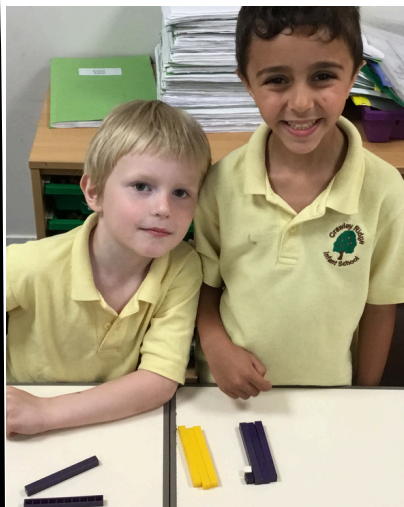




# This week in KS1 we have...

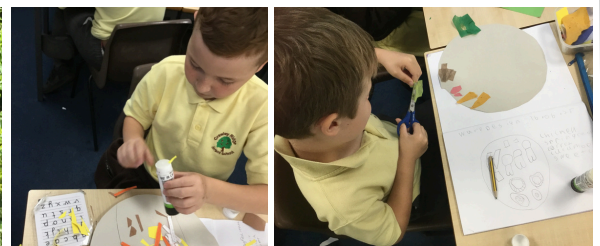

WOW what a scorching week we have had, and as the week has gone on it has got hotter and hotter! The children have coped remarkably well (better than the adults!) and their learning this year has started to show all of their hard work in Year 1 coming together nicely in both their writing and their maths. English this week has seen the children writing a report based on our story **"Clean Up!"** by *Nathan Bryon*. The children have written their own headlines about the plastic problem on the beaches of Jamaica, and they have then shared what the clean-up crew did to sort the problem, before finally writing about what the characters did to ensure this disaster never happened again. Maths saw us working on our understanding of place value, but this time comparing numbers using our more than, less than, or equal symbols. We focussed first on numbers that had the same number of tens so that we just looked at the ones in each number, before moving on to randomly generated numbers. Our learning in Geography had us exploring lighthouses from around the world, looking at the common features they all have, as well as finding out exactly how they help to keep boats safe around the coastlines of different countries. Finally, Year 1 had a go at developing our sewing skills this week, learning how to do a running stitch and other types of patterns in our sewing in preparation for sewing our puppets together next week. Year 1 need lots of volunteer sewers next Wednesday (25.6.25) afternoon from 1.15pm. The more the merrier as it means we can then work in much smaller groups. Let your child's class teacher know if you can help out. Have a great weekend and try and stay cool! The Year 1 Team.
