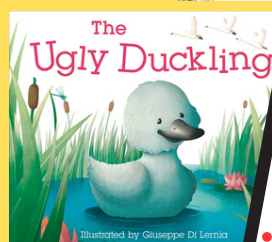

This week in early years, we have...

This week in Nursery, we have been enjoying the story **We're Going on an Egg Hunt**, which has inspired lots of lovely Easter-themed learning. The children have taken part in a range of creative activities, including making Easter cards, using playdough to shape their own eggs, and exploring potato printing to create colourful egg patterns. We've also made chocolate nests and enjoyed our own egg hunts outside. Alongside our Easter fun, we have also been busy investigating in our learning. The children explored which objects float and sink, and experimented with magnetic and non-magnetic materials, showing great curiosity and enthusiasm. We also said a sad goodbye to our ducklings on Thursday, as they returned to the farm to continue growing. The children have loved caring for them and learning about how they grow and change; it has been such a special experience for us all. We hope you all have a wonderful and restful Easter break, and we look forward to seeing you when we return!

This week our story focus was **The Odd Egg**, which linked well to our Easter activities. The children enjoyed creating Easter crafts and taking part in small Easter hunts around the classroom and outdoor areas. On Monday we held a special afternoon for Mrs Robinson and her baby. Thank you for all of your thoughtful gifts that were sent in, these were presented along with a book made by Ruby Class giving name suggestions and thoughts on whether the baby will be a boy or a girl. The children also explored baby themed activities including a washing station, nappy changing role play, baby care and designing a baby outfit. We were also pleased to welcome Rania's mum on Tuesday morning, who talked to the children about Ramadan and Eid. She brought prayer mats, decorations and clothing for the children to look at, helping them understand the celebrations and their focus on peace and patience. Several children also shared their own experiences, which was lovely to hear. In writing, we looked at the progression of the children's work. Each term they are given the same picture and asked to write a simple sentence. It has been great to see how much their writing has developed so far. In maths, we explored more complex patterns where we have been creating them, continuing them and identifying mistakes. We finished the week with our Easter bonnet parade and sing song, which the children thoroughly enjoyed and we hope you did too. We hope you all have a wonderful Easter break.

This week in KS1 we have...

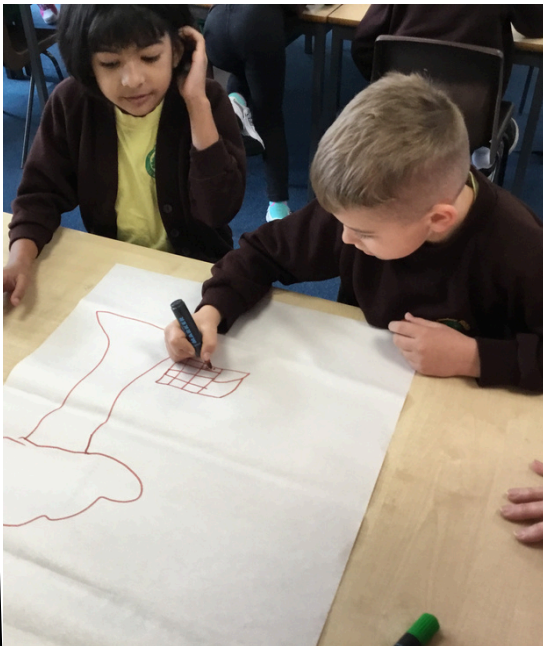

Can you believe it- that's the Spring term done and dusted. A term of progress and growth for all of the children, developing their independence as learners and increasing their confidence when faced with a challenge or new experience. In our writing this week we have been creating our own newspaper reports about the story of **Alexander T Wolf aka the Big Bad Wolf**. We have come up with some catchy headlines and have tried really hard to capture the essence of the story as concisely as possible. This has been a real challenge for the children, to focus in on the most important parts of the story, but they all did a fantastic job. During Maths we have been taking a closer look at time, working on knowing the different parts of an analogue clock (minute hand and hour hand) as well as becoming familiar with the hand positions for o'clock and half past the hour. As we come to the end of our blocks of learning in PSHE, Science and DT, we have been doing a lot of evaluating of our learning. We looked at how our fruit salad turned out in DT, we recalled how effective our waterproof hats were at keeping Mr Lynch dry in Science, whilst in PSHE we have looked back at how we can look after and care for different things, including ourselves, our friends, our pets and our planet. We're looking forward to welcoming some **new children** into our sessions next term, and we wish you all a **lovely Easter break**.

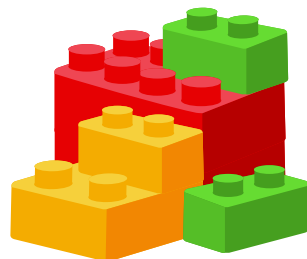
