The focus of the assembly was democracy, and they had put together a short video to share with the school including interviews with members of staff where they asked questions about what democracy is and the impact of voting. Democracy is one of our British Values and the children really embraced investigating what it means. Well done, School Council! Over the next couple of weeks, democracy will be in action here at Crawley Ridge as the children vote in all classes to see who their school councillors for the Summer Term will be.

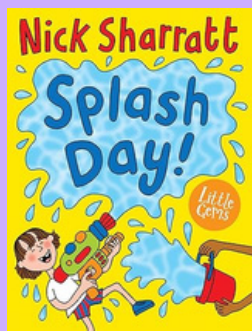
**Check the Calendar** Please make sure you take a look at the calendar in this newsletter and set reminders for any important dates coming up - it's a busy term ahead!

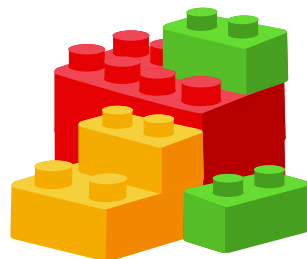
