**Reception Pirate Day-** Reception children had a fantastic time today for their Pirate Day! Thank you so much for all the amazing costumes. The children spent the whole day fully in pirate theme, completing their learning and enjoying lots of exciting activities. A huge thank you to the staff for organising such a brilliant day. We hope the children enjoyed it as much as we did!

**Attendance Matters-** A reminder that children should be in school every day unless they are genuinely unwell or there is another authorised reason for absence. Every day missed from school has an impact on children's learning, confidence and progress. If a child has 10 unauthorised sessions, which is the same as 5 school days, within a 10 week rolling period, this could result in a fine from Surrey County Council. Penalty notices are issued per parent, per child. For a first penalty notice, the fine is £80 if paid within 21 days, rising to £160 if paid between 22 and 28 days. A second penalty notice within three years is £160, with no reduction. A third offence may result in Surrey County Council considering prosecution. Please speak to us if you are worried about your child's attendance. We are here to help.

**Phonics Screening Check-** A massive congratulations to our Year 1 children and some of our Year 2 children who completed their Phonics Screening Check this week. You all did incredibly well, and we are very proud of you. Parents will receive their child's phonics screening score in their end of year report, which will be sent out in July. Thank you to all parents who have supported phonics practice at home. A special thank you from me to our Year 1 staff, and to Mrs Webb and Mrs Botting, who run our early morning phonics and play club for selected Year 1 children. Your hard work makes such a difference.

**Headteacher of the Day-** Congratulations to Finlay in Sapphire Class, who has won Headteacher of the Day! We had almost 350 entries, raising money for our PTA. A random name selector was used to select the winner, and next Thursday, Mr F. Goldsmith will become Headteacher for the day, giving Mr O'Shea a much needed day to rest and relax. Thank you in advance, Mr Goldsmith! Thank you to everyone who entered and helped raise much needed funds for our school. I wish everyone could be a winner, but that would be absolute chaos!

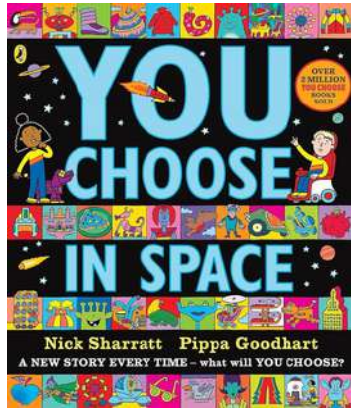
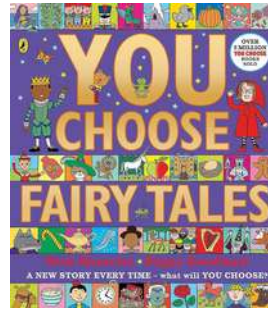
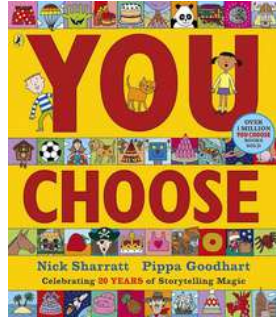

# This week in early years, we have...

NUR

This week, we have read **Amazing Aeroplanes and Super Submarines**, and have enjoyed learning all about vehicles that travel through the sky and across or under the water. The children have taken part in a range of creative activities, including making their own kites, which we hope to test next week (weather permitting!). They have also designed and made boats and junk-modelled treasure chests linked to our sea theme. The children have engaged enthusiastically in imaginative play, taking part in lifeboat rescue missions and creating their own airports, with helicopters and aeroplanes taking off and landing. In maths, we have been learning about 3D shapes and exploring which shapes can roll and which can stack. We will continue our learning about shapes next week. Next week, we will be reading *Roaring Rockets* and getting stuck into space, planets, moons and stars! This week, the children climbed aboard the Crawley Ridge pirate ship and transformed into a crew of adventurous pirates! Our story of the week was **Pirate Mums**, which inspired lots of imaginative play and exciting learning opportunities. The children made stick puppet pirates, created treasure maps and enjoyed exploring our small world pirate boats and figures. We also investigated floating and sinking, tested our own ideas when making junk model boats and painted beautiful sea backgrounds featuring our pirate ship sailing across the waves. To round off our pirate adventure, we held a fantastic Pirate Day! The children came to school ready for adventure and spent the day hunting for treasure, making telescopes and creating jewellery from the treasure pieces they had decorated earlier in the week. There was plenty of pirate fun, teamwork and imaginative play throughout the day. In Maths, we have been recapping patterns. The children have been creating repeating patterns using three colours and practising describing them, for example, "The pattern is blue, green, pink." We have also begun exploring positional language and using words such as *on*, *under*, *behind* and *next to*, to describe where objects are located. In Writing, the children were shocked to discover that our trick box dog, Doodles, had been taken by pirates! To help find him, they created missing posters and carefully described what he looked like, thinking about his appearance and key features so that he could be identified and returned safely.

This week has been Phonic Screening Check week for Year 1. Both Ms Williams and my self spent the first part of the week with the children, individually going through the 40 alien and real words to test their phonic knowledge. Each and every one of the children did the most incredible job, showing off their skills and making the whole Year 1 team incredibly proud. Well done children- you were AWESOME!!! Even though this was going on, it didn't mean the learning had come to a stop. In English we have been writing about environmental issues such as littering, plastic pollution and deforestation. We are really upping our focus on independence and it has been a delight to see all the children rising to the challenge. During maths we have making sure that the children are aware of how numbers also exist as words, not just as numerals. We have been practising these in written form, trying to get the children to spot patterns in how the words are spelt, for example all the teen numbers with teen at the end and the numbers in our ten times table from 20 all ending in -ty. In DT we have been getting ready for our puppet making by practising our joining skills before moving on to sewing next week. In science we moved on to the next animal group, this week learning about birds and what key features make them special. History saw us finding out more about lighthouses over time, whilst in PE we have been practising hard for sports day. Have a great weekend. The Year 1 Team.
