# What I Bring to Nursery

Acorn Class Nursery

Please make sure everything is named so it can come back to me.



School uniform and sensible shoes.



Named wellies and a waterproof coat for outdoor play.



A water bottle.



A bag with spare clothes, nappies or wipes if needed.



A healthy packed lunch if I am full time or attend an afternoon session.

# Lunch and Snack

Acorn Class Nursery

Food helps me have energy to play and learn.



Children who are full time or attend an afternoon session need a healthy packed lunch.



Packed lunches must not contain nuts or chocolate.  
Grapes and olives must be cut in half to reduce choking risk.  
Sausages must be sliced lengthways.



Children who only attend a morning session do not need a packed lunch.



Children need a healthy snack for both morning and afternoon sessions.  
Full day children need two snacks.  
Healthy snacks only, such as fruit, breadsticks or cheese.

**The adults will help me open my lunch box or snack if I need help.**

## Where I Play and Learn
