

TAMAT Schools - Covid-19 Home School Agreement

<p>The school will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID19 infection • Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can • Provide an education that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs • Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19 • Inform you if staff or children in your child's group show symptoms of COVID19 as you may wish to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative • We will follow the revised Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement • Communicate between home and school through ParentMail and the school website 	<p>To help my child at school, I know and understand that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or email • If my child shows symptoms of Covid-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately when notified • On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules • When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child • My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell • I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully • My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene • I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment. All communication with staff via telephone or email • I need to support all staff in their efforts to create a safe environment during this crisis • I will wash my child's clothes, lunchbox and drink bottle every day • I will read all ParentMail messages that are sent via email • I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carers and emergency contacts details before my child returns to school • If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe (agreed by the Headteacher) 	<p>I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground • Tell an adult if I feel unwell • Not use anyone else's equipment or stationery • Not mix with any other children in the school other than my 'bubble' • Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate/door • Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it) • Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser • Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others (following amended behaviour policy and rules set out by all staff) • Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe
